Summer Youth Camp Information

Pricing and Payment

Junior Camp will cost \$95 if registered by May 27th. **A pre-registration deposit of \$20 is due by May 27. This deposit will be deducted for the total cost. \$10 late fee will be added after May 21st Camp Cost AFTER May 27th is \$105.**

Teen Camp will cost \$130 if registered by June 3rd. **A pre-registration deposit of \$20 is due by June 3rd. This deposit will be deducted from the total cost. You can register after June 3rd, but a late fee will be added. Camp Cost after June 3rd is \$140.**

Pre-registration is essential in planning all camps. The additional fee helps to alleviate any additional expenses incurred due to unexpected campers. Anyone who wishes to pay the full amount in advance is encouraged to do so.

Items to Bring

Money for concessions at camp, modest and comfortable outdoor clothing that is appropriate for a Christian camp facility & shoes (tennis shoes are required for some activities), sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and pillow, soap, shampoo, towels, washcloths, swimsuit (one piece only or t-shirt to cover; the Pool will only allow **white** t-shirts in the water), sunscreen, insect repellent, flashlight, Bible, notebook, and pen.

MP3's, iPods and CD players are allowed at teen camps, but to play **Christian music ONLY** and only for use during free times. **No electronics at junior camp please.** Camp Overton is not responsible for any items lost or left at camp.

Cell phones are discouraged at camp in part because they can be a disruption and also because cell service is unpredictable. Video game systems, silly string, or toys are not to be brought to camp.

Any personal items which become a distraction to activities or services may be confiscated and will be returned at the end of camp. We cannot be responsible for lost, stolen, or left behind items, so please leave unnecessary valuables at home.

Junior Camp begins on Monday at 2pm and end on the last day at 11:00 am.

Teen Camp begins on Monday at 2pm and ends on Friday at 2pm.
