Junior Camp Information Sheet

Pricing and Payment

Junior Camp will cost \$115 if registered by May 23rd. **A pre-registration deposit of \$20 is due by May 23rd. This deposit will be deducted from the total cost. You can register after May 23rd, but a late fee will be added. Camp Cost after May 23rd is \$125.**

Pre-registration is essential in planning all camps. The additional fee helps to alleviate any additional expenses incurred due to unexpected campers. Anyone who wishes to pay the full amount in advance is encouraged to do so.

Items to Bring

Money for concessions at camp, **modest** and comfortable outdoor clothing that is appropriate for a Christian camp facility & shoes (tennis shoes are required for some activities), sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and pillow, soap, shampoo, towels, washcloths, swimsuit (one piece only or t-shirt to cover; the Pool will only allow **white** t-shirts in the water), sunscreen, insect repellent, flashlight, Bible, notebook, and pen.

We ask that **Christian music ONLY** be played while at camp. Camp Overton is not responsible for any items lost or left at camp.

Any personal items which become a distraction to activities or services may be confiscated and will be returned at the end of camp. We cannot be responsible for lost, stolen, or left behind items, so please leave unnecessary valuables at home.
